The <u>Social Supermarket</u> is about so much more than food!

Members pay £3 per week to shop, and can join activities, receive advice and support that help make positive changes to their lives.

The Social Supermarket was the first group that Making Our Money Go Further were able to provide regular face to face support for and we joined them just as some new members had started.

Since July 2021 we have helped over 30 clients in a variety of ways. Some have been referred through to Citizens Advice Rotherham for individual support, others have formed or joined groups the project supports, some have been signposted to other services but for many, just to have someone to chat to was all the help they needed.

September saw many of the people we first met in July graduate from the Social Supermarket and it's been an absolute honour for us to have helped support them through that journey.

I've attended lots of events and sessions this month. As well as supporting clients at the Rotherham Foodbank and Social Supermarket each week, MOMGF were in Maltby at a pop up event with the local ward councillors and other organisations where I was able to talk to people about our service.
