'Tenancy Health Check' visits

The Scrutiny Panel said:

What the Council did:



Change the name of the visits to make it clearer what they are for.

The visits are now called 'Tenancy Reviews'



Make sure that people can have support from someone who can help them to explain their views during visits.

The letters sent about the visits now give details of how to get someone to support people during the tenancy review if they want this.



Give plenty of notice about the visit and send reminders.

Tenants get a letter 2-4
 weeks before the visit.
 The Council are looking at how reminders could be sent by text or email.



Be clearer about the visits being about supporting and helping tenants as well as looking at their home and garden.

The 'Guide to your Home' leaflet and the website have been updated to make this clearer.

'Tenancy Health Check' visits

The Scrutiny Panel said:

What the Council did:



Make it clear how people can change the date of their visit, and which officers are visiting.

The letters have been changed to add the contact details and name the officers if possible.



Make sure that different officers do the same things during the visits, have the same training, and that the visits are checked by their managers.

✓ All officers have been trained, and checks are in place to make sure that visits are carried out as they should be.



Carry out more tenancy review visits to people if they need more support or help (not just every 4 years).

 Officers will look at how often they should visit to suit each tenant.



Make sure that visits also look at if there are too many people living in the home, advice on mobility scooter storage, and the future needs of the tenant.

✓ The tenancy review will include talking about all these points if needed.

We would like to thank everyone who was involved in this work; including the panel volunteers, the tenants who answered the survey and Rotherham Council officers.


